Teams from all over the county entered the Green Beret Challenge at Phasels Wood on the 18 November 2017.

The Green Beret Challenge is a full day's competition for teams of six. It runs from first light until 2300 hrs on Saturday. To achieve the Green Beret Challenge, teams compete in FOUR elements: Orienteering, Assault Course, Challenge Incidents (Daytime) and a Night Exercise. Letchworth and Baldock District entered 36 Scouts from 2nd Baldock, 4th Letchworth, 5th Letchworth, 7th Letchworth and 12th Letchworth, combining to make 6 teams.

The Challenge is designed to test a group of Scouts through a range of physical and intellectual activities and by the evening the Scouts were all looking like they had been well and truly challenged. The highlights included seeing who can get the most muddy on the Assault course, climb the van in the day bases and a huge variety of bases laid on including one by Goodie and Glenn Read. All the Scouts sleep well on Saturday night.

The weekend finished at 1100 hrs on Sunday with the presentation ceremony. Not all things run to plan and the winners of the Orienteering Trophy for the County (The 2nd Baldock and 4th Letchworth combined team) weren't able to find their way to stage to receive the Trophy during

Lochearnhead Expedition 2017

Our latest expedition to the wonderful activity base, Lochearnhead Scout Station situated in the Southern Highlands of Scotland has been another resounding success. Over the 2 weeks between 29 July and 12 August we had 100 Young people from our District attend this challenging week of activities. To ensure that each and everyone gets the most out of their time "on station" we run 2 separate weeks with 50 Young People attending each week. To support all this we had a fabulous team of 40 Leaders each week, around 30 of these did both weeks! This team of adults included Leaders from our District, Mid Herts District plus Surrey, Essex, Sheffield and Ayr County Leaders. We have friends everywhere in Scouting who love to come and join us in delivering exciting Scouting when the call goes out. In our number we had support from some wonderful parent helpers on each week who threw themselves into the activities with great energy and like the rest of us came home tired but really excited about what they had been part of.

What did our Scouts do you may ask. Over the 7 days they were there they took part in hikes in the mountains, sailed on the Loch, climbed on a local rock face, mountain bike rides on local tracks, white water rafting, paintballing plus numerous small activities during quiet times on the station. As you can see, not much time for sitting around!

The weather on the first week did its best to drown us with rain most of the time for the first 4 days but in true Scouting fashion we undertook the wet weather programme – WEAR YOUR WATERPROOFS – and continued to do everything as we had planned. The Scouts loved it. No complaints, no problems just great fun. To ensure the Young People got the most from their hikes we sent the oldest 10 Explorers out for 3 days, the majority of the Scouts for 2 days and the Youngest had 2 separate 1 day hikes, this way the Leader Teams could ensure that everyone achieved the best experience whilst out in the wilds. Fortunately the second week proved less challenging and we even had some sunshine, oh and midges of course!

We had our share of "challenges" while we were there (and before we even got there) but the team faced them in true spirit and delivered an absolutely brilliant time to all those attending.

Thanks to every single person who contributed in any way from the initial planning to the arrival back in Letchworth & Baldock.
