3. Attend the meeting, as she always looks forward to them.


County Activity Centre Announcement

The County has recently concluded a review of how it operates the County Centres in order to deliver the best possible service and value for their members. They continue to be focussed on how they can help make it easier for their membership to deliver the outdoor element of the Scouting programme and how they make the best use of their limited resource.


The outcome of this review is that they will be moving the booking, administration and financial management of Well End and Harmergreen Wood to Phasels Wood – where they can offer a 7 day a week service responding to telephone, e-mail and web form based bookings. This will be in place from early 2019.

Operational management of Well End will pass to the team at Phasels Wood, under the direction of Doug Stack. Operational management of Harmergreen Wood will pass to the team at Tolmers under the direction of Chris Rainbow. There should be no impact on any bookings that you have made or wish to make at the Centres.

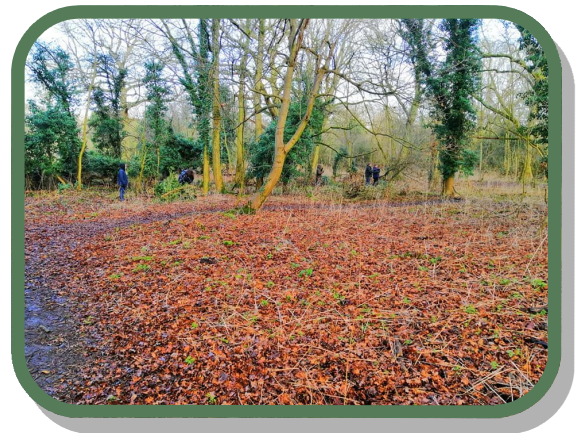
