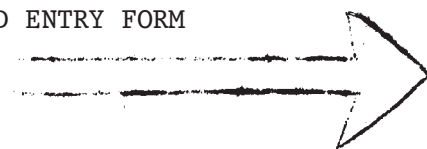
VENTURE SCOUTS

ESSENTIAL; Night hiking kit with white or reflecting outer garments or large patches (armbands are NOT sufficient), Scout beret and Group neckerchief; torches, mugs, personal first aid kit, notebook, pencils, some 2p pieces for emergency, reliable watches, 1" map 147 or 1:50,000 sheet 166. Teams will get map references to walk to checkpoints for Scouting projects at set times, with one rest (soup provided) after midnight, the contest finishing about 0600 Sunday.
