LOCHERNHEAD "WARM-UP" AT WESTON

Everything went according to plan at the 'mock-Lochernhead'Expedition'. At 9.30 a.m. on Sunday. 21st May, the masses gathered outside St, Paul's church to be signed in by the Rt. Honourable Mr. Jeffrey Rohson (ADC Scouts). The Scouts, Guides, Ventures and Rangers'were then grouped into parties of about six. These parties of mixed sex then walked the four or five miles to Weston Camp by a variety of routes.

On arrival the 'participants' were reorganised into five groups, rotated around the main field and subjected to the various exhibitions. These were:

Emergency drilling, by Messieurs Horwood (Ali) and Cox (Alan) (CHVSU) who, after displaying first aid and survival kits, demonstrated the making of 2 different types of rope stretcher.

Next in line was an ORIENTEERING exercise, spanning a vast area at the bottom end of the main field, which only confirmed what we already suspected - we'll have a treasure hunt for 80 missing Scouts and Guides on the 25th August (not really!).

Following this came a demonstration of various COOKING metheds and the safe use of pressure stoves, butane stoves, etc. This, which included some practical work for the Scouts and Guidés, was demonstrated by Peter Deary.

Then came the tent erecting section. Here 4 brave Venture Scouts, P. Moys, K. Osborne, A. Osborne (CHVSU) and A. Brett (BSVSU) supervised as the hike tents (of various shapes and sizes) were erected and 'taken' down. Reports would suggest that CHVSU's own abomination was found to be the most testing - which would support the fact that Rangers Jenny May and Suzanne Calver thought it wiser to use the tent in what is commonly known as "the all over the floor stance".

Last was a demonstration by Nigel Pitchers (of CHVSU) on BASIC EQUIPMENT necessary for such an expedition as Lochernhead '78, or, as it came straight
