

#### SECTION LEADER TRAINING

This year a new programme of Section Leader Training has been introduced. It is outlined in the chart below and the opportunities within Hertfordshire for undertaking this training in 1989 are listed on the next page.

All Leaders should seek to complete their training as soon as possible - not only does it help improve the quality of Scouting but enhances the Leader confidence and enjoyment of their role in the movement.



Between each stage of training and with the support of a personal training adviser and other Leaders and Commissioners within tige District participants undertake suitable projects.

At the completion of Leadership Two the participant completes further projects which include the preparation of a personal plan for training in the future. After this and if satisfied the District Commissioner may recommend the award of a Wood Badge.
