DISTRICT JAMBOREE 1996

Each of the Group representatives should have received a copy of the letter for parents, which is to be copied and given out to all Cubs, Scouts and Venture Scouts in your Group. This letter just tells parents the date of the Jamboree and the cost. There is a reply slip on the bottom of the letter which is to be returned to the Group to indicate their childs interest in attending the Jamboree. It is up to each Group how they collect the Jamboree fees (le:instalments, deposit, full amount) but all monies need to be collected by April 5th. This letter may also be given to any Beaver who will be 8 years old (ie:in Cubs) by the date of the Jamboree (May 3rd) There will be a separate letter for Beavers at a later date as they will be visiting the Jamboree during the day only.

The costs for the Jamboree are: - Cubs/Scouts/Ventures/Leaders camping - £20
Beavers/leaders visiting - £5 for 1 day; £7.50 for 2 days

Don't forget that each Group has been asked to come up with 2 ideas for the activity day on Sunday 5th May – one for the Beaver/Cub age group and one for the Scout/Venture age group. These activities are to be run at a minimal cost and it should be fairly easy for other leaders to take over the running of the activity during the day. This is so that no one leader is "stuck" on one activity for a whole day. Please pass your ideas onto your Group rep in time for the February meeting – 7th Feb.
