




St George's Day Parade and Service Sunday 22nd April 2001 St Mary's Church - Ashwell

But I'm being fussy again. When I got home from my travels, I was delighted to hear that Saturday's show was a wow. I was sure it would be.




Their were enjoyable song's, dances, jokes and many, many more.

Last year about this time details were given in advance about the level of the next year's subscription (i.e. that for 2001). The Scout Association undertook to try to follow this pattern in future years, notwithstanding the difficulties in forecasting numbers, expenditure, and the external financial climate more than a year ahead.

At its meeting, the Committee of the Council considered a detailed report on the Association's finances, including the budget for the financial year just about to start. It also received a parallel report on the initial returns from this year's census - which, to their regret appear to indicate a further decline in recorded numbers. In the light of all the information available, the Committee has decided that the **Headquarters**' membership subscription for **2002** will be £15.30, with a rebate of 35p for prompt payment.

I hope that you and your Groups will welcome this early notification, and that it will help your budgeting arrangements.
