#### The Queen's Golden Jubilee

Her Majesty the Queen has requested that her Golden Jubilee focuses on the Commonwealth of Nations. The Commonwealth is a voluntary association made up of fifty four countries and a further 24 states from around the world. It includes over a quarter of the world's population and land surface. Half the population of the Commonwealth is under twenty five years old. All member countries recognise HM Queen Elizabeth II as the Head of the Commonwealth. The Head of the Commonwealth acts as a focus but has no constitutional or executive function. It is purely symbolic.
