The route is mainly following the Garden City Greenway, diverting to Wymondley Wood and also passing the newly converted Norton Bury, visiting the new and the old.

The start is at Standalone Farm and the course approximately 13.6 miles (21.8 km). You do not have to complete the whole distance; transport will be available from the check points to take you back to Standalone Farm.

Walkers under 15 years of age, either individually or in a group, must be accompanied by an adult.

A registration fee of £1.00 per walker helps with administration and refreshment costs.
